

Information on the processing of personal data

In accordance with art. 13 of (EU) Regulation nr. 2016/679, the processing of personal data, provided or otherwise acquired in the context of the execution of the current Agreement, is aimed at the only execution of the selection, publication required by law, management of the contractual relationship, archiving, storage, process access management, civic access, generalized access and other forms of access and it will take place at the Institution premises by authorized personnel, with the use of procedures also computerized, in the ways and within the limits, necessary to pursue the above-mentioned aims. The data will be kept in conformity and for the duration provided by the rules on the administrative documentation preservation and in order to preconstitute any evidence for the protection of the rights, arising from the contract.

The provision of such data is necessary to fulfill the above-described purposes.

The collected data may be communicated to companies, including IT companies, which provide services to the Rightholder, according to specific responsibility contracts according to the art. 28 GDPR. They can also be known by law firms, referees, insurances, Treasury only as necessary for the purposes described. Some information will be communicated to other institutional bodies, public administrations, institutions, public companies, also for the purposes of projects reporting or for shared Administrative Services or for other purposes provided by law.

The interested parties have the right to obtain by Informest, in the envisaged cases, access to the personal data and the rectification or the cancellation of the same or the limitation of the treatment which affects them or to oppose the treatment (art. 15 et seq. of the Regulation). The appropriate instance is submitted by contacting Data Protection Manager at the address rpd@informest.it.

The interested parties who believe that the processing of personal data referred to themselves is in breach of the Regulation provisions have the right to propose a complaint, as provided by art. 77 of the same Regulation, or to refer to the appropriate judicial offices (art. 79 of the Procedure Rules).
